and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. (19:1)

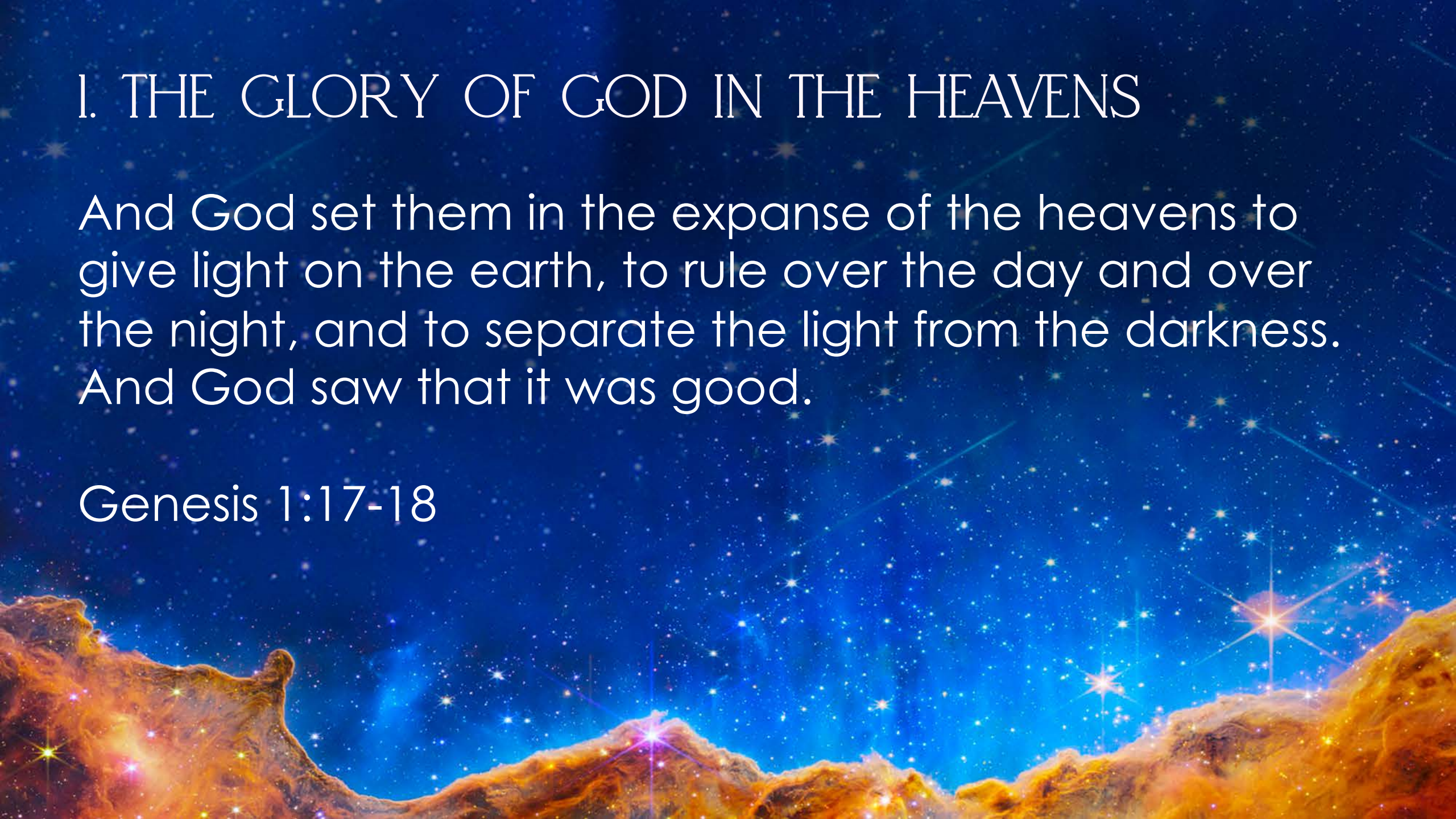




# I. THE GLORY OF GOD IN THE HEAVENS

and their words to the end of the world (19:2-4a)

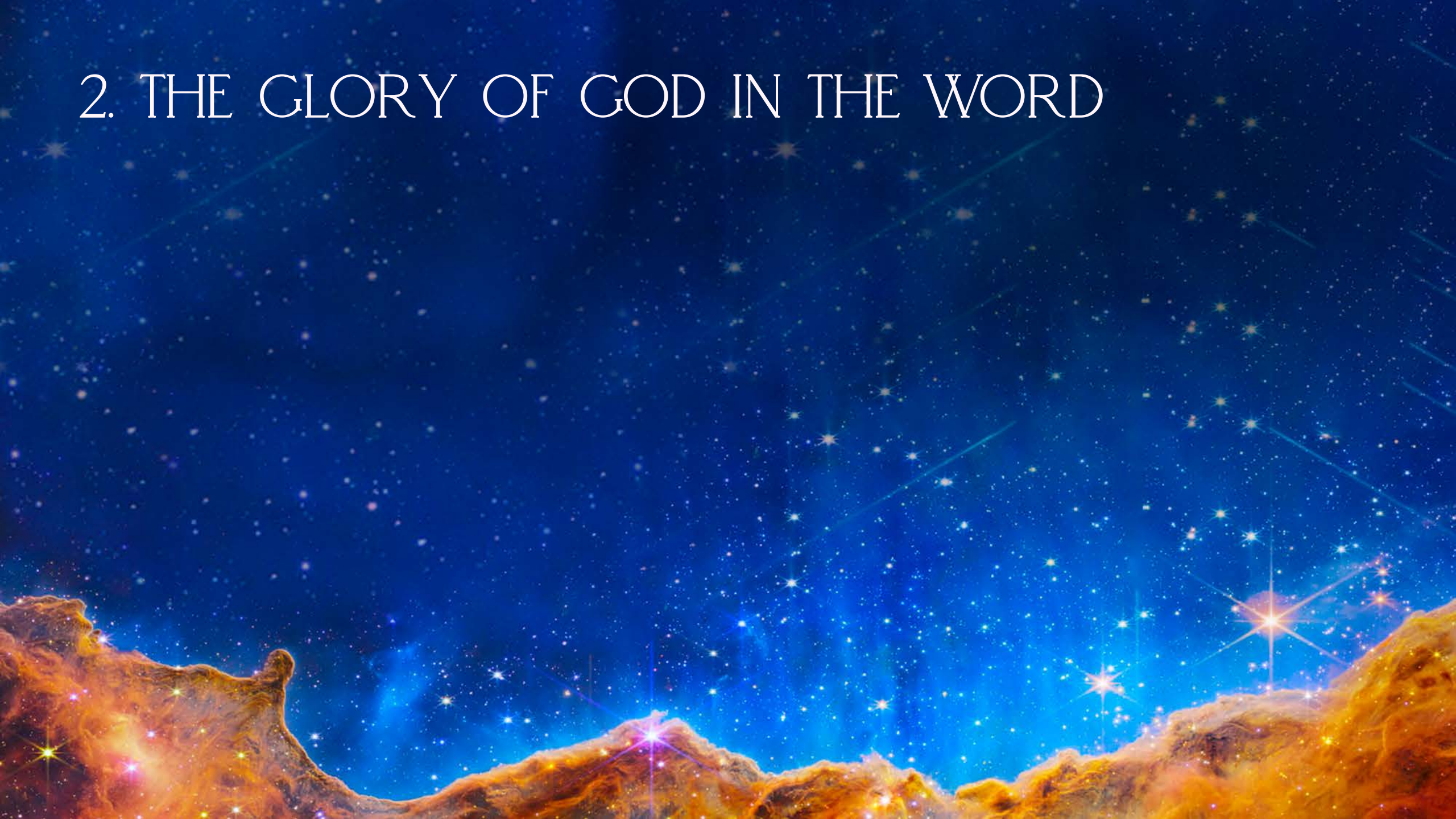


# I. THE GLORY OF GOD IN THE HEAVENS

- <sup>5</sup> In them he has set a tent for the sun,

and drippings of the honeycomb.

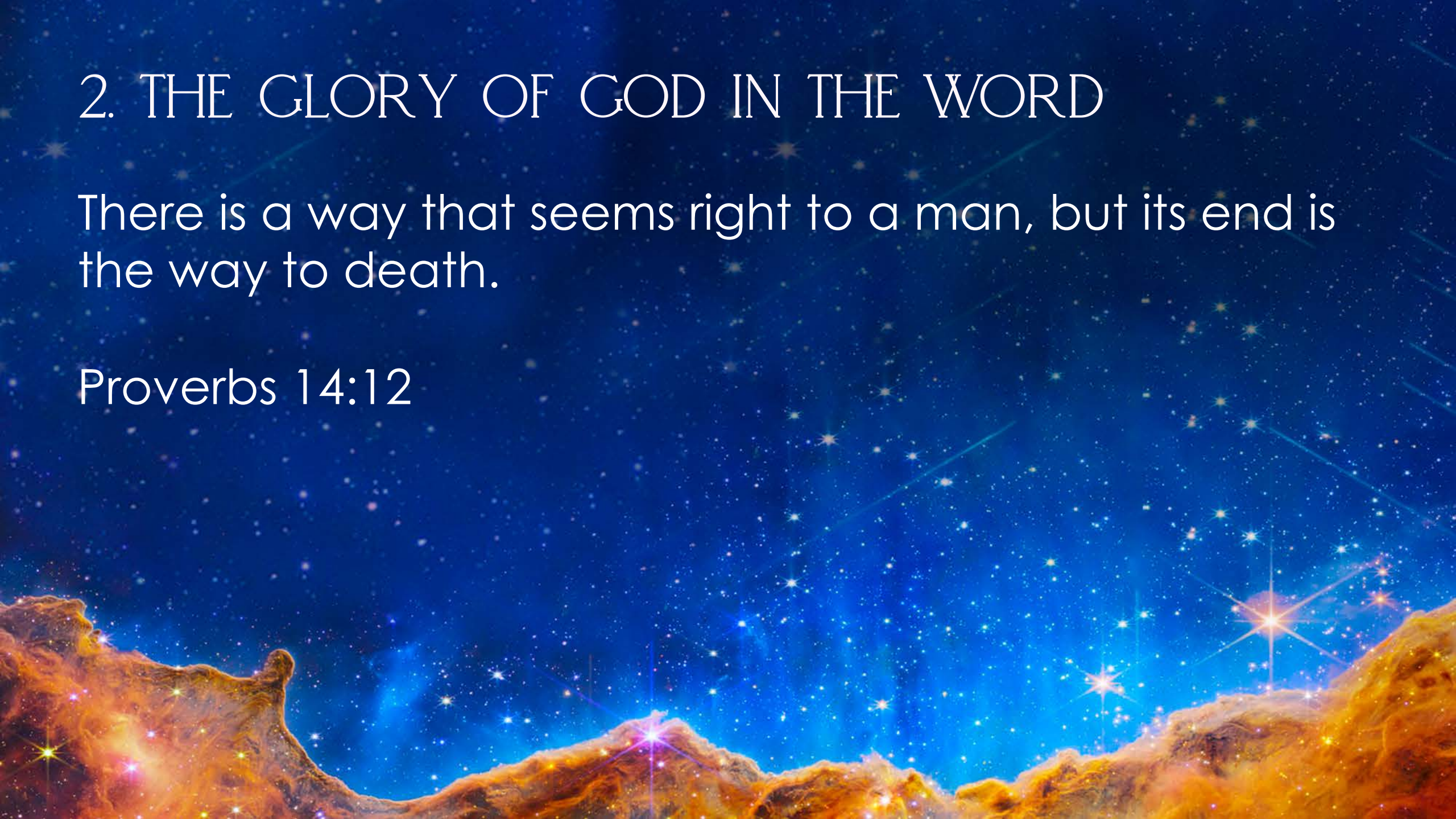
<sup>11</sup> Moreover, by them is your servant warned;

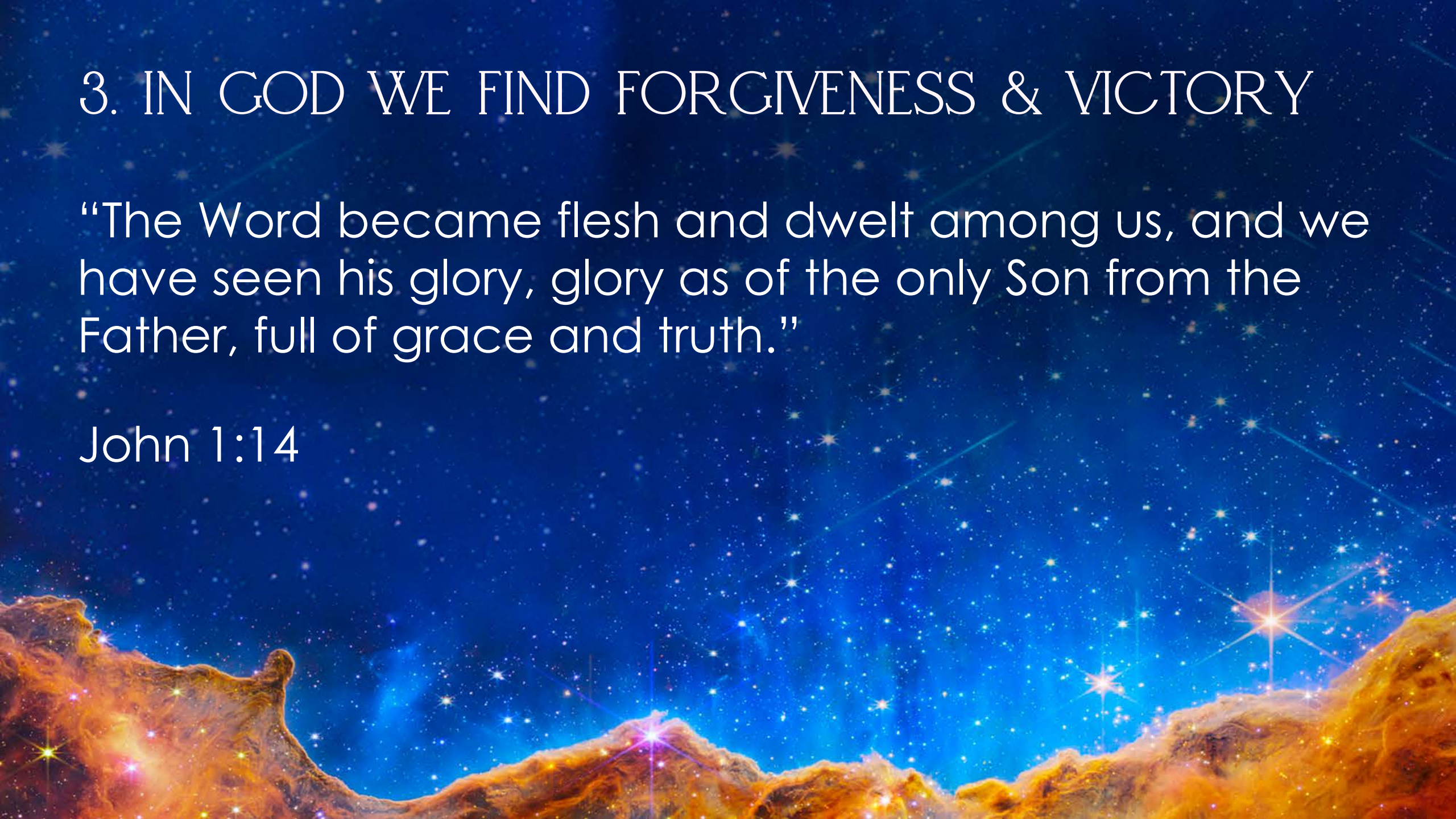
